You provide -

- Employer's name, address
- Debtor's social security number
- Copy of Money Judgment
- Original Writ of Execution
- Signed Application for EWO

If no Writ, Check payable to Clerk of Superior Court (\$15.00)

- Check payable to Sheriff Department (\$30.00)
- Check Payable to D & R (\$90 - \$150)

D & R PROVIDES: Necessary paperwork for Notice of Levy or Earnings Withholding Order; Opens file with appropriate Sheriff's Department; Serves bank or employer; Returns Proof of Service to Sheriff's Department & Mails copy of proof to you.
